ALL NEW ZEALAND PHOTO COMPETITION 2010

PGG WRIGHTSON PHOTO COMPETITION

Conditions of entry:

An annual competition open to all NZ Ayrshire cattle that are to be judged from photographs.

Closing Date: 26 February 2010

Classes:

1. 2 year olds
2. 3 year olds
3. 4 & 5 year olds
4. 6 years & over
5. Herd Scene
6. Yearling Heifer
7. Heifer Calf
8. Open class, individual female cattle of any age with backgrounds that may or may not be enhanced. No digital enhancement or alteration of animals is permitted.

Publishing: The Wrightson All NZ, Reserve All NZ and Merit runner-up photos will be published in the Spring Bulletin and on the Association website.

Rules:

1. Photos to be postcard size, colour or black & white. Photos may also be submitted as a print on quality photo grade paper electronically stored as 300 dpi minimum in a .jpg file and provided on CD or by e mail. Ayrshire New Zealand takes no responsibility for the quality of photos not submitted via these methods.
2. Open to animals that are full pedigree, ARA or ARB and are registered with the New Zealand Ayrshire Association. Also animals that are under 1 year of age and are eligible under this criteria.

4. With the exception of class 8 all photos must be the original photograph. No digital enhancement or alteration of animals is permitted.
5. Photos to be entered by the owner as at 1 February 2010.
6. Only one photo per animal per class may be entered, but where the same photo is also entered in Class 8 a further copy of the photo must be provided.
7. Judging will be conducted by 3 senior judges prior to 9 April 2010. Class 5 - Herd Scene will be judged by the publicity personnel. In the event of a tie an adjudicating judge will be appointed. The points basis is as follows: 1st - 10 pts; 2nd - 8 pts; 3rd - 6 pts; 4th - 4 pts; 5th - 2 pts; 6th - 1 pt
8. In the event of a draw the entry with the most first placings wins. If still even, count seconds and so on.
9. All entries will be displayed at the AGM and on the Association website and will be used as the basis of a members judging competition.
 - The first six animals in each class (except Class 5 – Herd Scene) as judged by the overjudges will form the Members Competition.
 - The Members Competition will take place via the Association website from 1 May annually and at the Association Annual Meeting.
10. Any entry may be used for promotional purposes by Ayrshire New Zealand.
