## Bull DNA Collection

DNA collection on bulls for DNA parentage prior to registration. See below for explanation.

Number of bull calves to be sampled:

All bulls born after 1 June 2017 must be DNA parentage tested prior to registration. To make this process easier for members we are offering a DNA collection service as part of the TOP schedule.

***This service is available to ALL Ayrshire New Zealand members whether they are completing TOP Classification or not.***

- Members will indicate numbers for sampling on the TOP Classification application (see over).
- On the scheduled day all bull calves for sampling must be held at or adjacent to the Milking Shed.
- Inspectors will use DNA punches supplied by GeneMark to collect samples.
- Members must also supply the completed Genemark documentation to Inspectors at the time of collection.
- The samples and documentation will be returned to the Ayrshire office and submitted to Genemark on the members behalf.
- All Genemark costs will be paid directly by the member.
- Results will be sent directly to the member from Genemark.
- There will be no charge to members who are classifying, and a small charge for all other members, see over for costs.
- For members on Lifetime Registrations or Standing Order, all records will be matched for automatic registration in the scheduled month. For all other members all bulls sampled will be invoiced and registered automatically.
